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Etymological Classification of the Vocabulary Used in *Wynnerer and Wastoure*

ABSTRACT

The aim of this short paper is to study the middle years of the 14th century (ca.1352) Northwest Midland Dialect. The main text is *Wynnerer and Wastoure* (anonymous), an alliterative poem. The study looks at the vocabulary, from an etymological point of view. The reader is referred to my previous articles on *Patience*, *Sir Gawain & the Green Knight*, and *Pearl*, in which I examined similar areas.

The combination of various forms of words from, for example, OFr., L., ON, OHG., Afr., suggests that this unknown author has a wide knowledge of many and varied languages. And one of the most noticeable aspects that I point out is that he was very well versed in heraldic terminology. Compared with other poems, this one contains a large number of Germanic languages.

本作品は W.W.Gollancz が 1897 年 *The Parlement of the Thre Ages* の Appendix として Roxburghe Club から出版したのが最初で、14 世紀の Thornton MS (British Museum Add) を底本にしている。テキストを精確に調査してみると夥しい数の誤謬や disputable points が認められ、きわめて不完全なものである。出版年次は不明であるが使用されている言語特性や詩形からみて 14 世紀（中期）に Northwest Midland Dialect で書かれたものであることは間違いない。内的資料によって 1353 年と断じられる (1.202)。Collancz は “Preface” において十余にあまる年代推定論拠をあげている。

頭韻詩の技巧的手法として所謂「類分裂」現象が大胆にみられるが、特筆すべきこととして「紋章」（学）に関する用語がかなり多用されている。この不明の著者は一見田紳といった印象を与えるが慮外に思慮に富んだ博洽の士であると思わせる憑拠が随所に認められる。

スペースの関係で全語彙についての記載が出来ないので今回は「名詞」と「動詞」に限定して *Wynnerer and Wastoure* の使用語彙の特性と言語的事実を解明することにする。

1. 記載語は基幹となるものだけに限定せず、本文中のものは全てその仮の綴字で記した。異綴のものも省略せず記した。
2. 同一語で多機能を有する語（「類分裂」[class cleavage]）は発生源になる品詞の部に入れた。
3. present participle, past participle は動詞範疇にいれる。
4. OE で既に合成語として確立しているものは単

純語とする。5. 名詞は単数形で表記する。6. スペースの関係で引用行数の明示は1例にする。7. 異形態は使用頻度の高い順に表記する。
